






To thrive in a rapidly changing world, and achieve health for all, we need educational systems that provide equal opportunities for ALL. That means:

When young people learn about <u>gender inequalities</u>, <u>discrimination</u> and <u>power dynamics</u> in CSE, they are five times more likely to act in a way that successfully prevents unintended pregnancy, HIV and sexually transmitted infections.



Political leadership and social momentum are coming together like never before.


